

PENNINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Meeting of January 4, 2022

The Pennington County Board of Commissioners met at 9:01 a.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 4, 2022, in the Commission Chambers in the County Administration Building, Rapid City, South Dakota. Chair Gary Drewes called the meeting to order with the following Commissioners present: Deb Hadcock, Lloyd LaCroix, Travis Lasseter and Ron Rossknecht.

ELECTIONS OF OFFICERS

MOVED by Hadcock and seconded by Lasseter to utilize voice roll call vote as the method of election. Vote: Unanimous.

MOVED by LaCroix and seconded by Rossknecht to nominate Drewes for Chair. Roll call vote: Hadcock, no; LaCroix, yes; Lasseter, no; Rossknecht, yes; Drewes, yes. The 2022 Chair is Commissioner Drewes.

MOVED by Rossknecht and seconded by Drewes to nominate Commissioner LaCroix for Vice-Chair.

MOVED by Hadcock and seconded by Lasseter to nominate Commissioner Lasseter for Vice-Chair.

Roll call vote for Commissioner LaCroix: Hadcock, no; LaCroix, yes; Lasseter, no; Rossknecht, yes; Drewes, yes. The 2022 Vice Chair is Commissioner LaCroix.

ESTABLISH COMMISSIONERS' SALARY

AND, the person delivering the pollbooks and ballot boxes to the proper authority at the county seat shall receive the county rate for mileage as established pursuant to § 7-7-24, for miles necessarily traveled in going to and returning from making the delivery.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE Pennington County Board of Commissioners, that the fee paid to the precinct superintendent be established at \$255, which includes \$30 for election school; the precinct deputy with experience at \$205, which includes \$30 for election school; and, the precinct deputy without experience at \$180, which includes \$30 for election school.

Enforcement Lieutenant, Law Enforcement Captain and Chief Deputy Sheriff as proposed effective July 24, 2022. Vote: Unanimous.

MOVED by LaCroix and seconded by Hadcock to place employees in the positions of Chief Deputy Sheriff and Law Enforcement Captain onto the law enforcement wage scale where they do not lose money plus one additional step effective July 24, 2022. Vote: Unanimous.

MOVED by LaCroix and seconded by Rossknecht to place the employees in the positions of Deputy Sheriff I, Deputy Sheriff II, Law Enforcement Sergeant and Law Enforcement Lieutenant onto the law enforcement wage scale through the below steps. Vote: Unanimous.

1. One additional step on the 2022 County Wage Scale effective January 9th, 2022 for all the above listed employees.
2. Place the above listed employees onto the law enforcement wage scale on the step where they do not lose money, with a minimum 2.5% increase for those with 4 or more years of service, plus one additional step for all listed employees effective July 24, 2022.

B. REQUEST TO MOVE MEDICAL POSITIONS TO INDEPENDENT WAGE SCALE AND PLACE POSITIONS ON SCALE FOR IMPLEMENTATION: MOVED by Hadcock and seconded by Lasseter to approve a separate medical wage scale for the medical positions of EMT, Paramedic, Licensed Practical Nurse, Registered Nurse, Certified Nurse Practitioner, Psychologist and Medical Director as proposed effective July 24, 2022 and place the employees in medical positions on the scale where they do not lose money. Vote: Unanimous.
